NITS's Accounting Services, in general, will include: Performing the routine accounting work of this National Training of Institute for Standardization [NITS] of the Bureau of Indian Standards [BIS] in Tally Accounting Software/ any other software as per the general principle of accounting and the internal guidelines/instructions of BIS Headquarters, New Delhi, and to take time bound appropriate action(s) as per the statutory requirements from time to time. In particular, the accounting services will include:
3. All transactions shall be kept in in tally software/any other software and reports shall be generated on periodical intervals, month wise, year-wise etc, and proper back-up of the records shall be maintained. Assisting in preparation of Receipts, Bank Payment Vouchers, Journals Vouchers, etc., and punching of these vouchers in "Tally Software" as per proper "Accounting Head" in consultation with management, will be onus of the Firm. All Ledger book(s) of Accounts shall be maintained and updated as per the requirements.
4. Preparation of Banks Reconciliation Statement (Income & Expenditure and Receipts & Payment) on monthly basis. The non-reconciled entries may be brought out, date-wise, instrument-wise, to the notice of NITS and the missing entries at the end of the month need to be identified and needs to be traced during the subsequent month. Firm to ensure that Bank Reconciliation Statements should not contain any long pending outstanding debit/credit entries.
5. Maintenance of information on Fixed Assets as per GFR 2017 format. Additions in Fixed Asset shall be recorded in Fixed Assets Register with its original purchase price, the accumulated depreciation and its current book value. Fixed Asset shall be removed from the Fixed Asset Register by the entry showing the manner of disposal.
6. Preparation of Trial Balance (on monthly/annual basis) as per BIS-Hqrs' Format and submission of final Trial Balance on or before 07th day of every month along with all requisite schedules to BIS-Hqrs. The assignment relating to the finalization of Annual Closing of Accounts, as per BIS Hqrs, New Delhi Guidelines, covering all aspects, namely, consolidation and finalization of accounts, bank reconciliation, filing of returns, etc., should be completed by 15th day of June of every year.
7. Maintenance of Party-wise Ledger in respect of all advances, claims, reimbursements, payments, recovery and expenses.
8. Preparation and e-filing of TDS and other returns periodically within the stipulated time and generation of TDS certificate to the concerned parties TDS rate on various contractor/sub-contractor, etc., as applied by NITS, while releasing payment to be checked and if inconsistency is found in applied rate, it would be the onus of CA firm to suggest the correct rate and recover the outstanding, if any, remains in process.

9. Taking corrective actions on NITS's Accounts Audit Para(s) raised by CAG/GST/TDS/BIS-Internal Auditors.
10. Rendering advices on the matters relating to all taxes (IT-TDS, GST, etc) as per central/state government notifications, from time to time. Firm shall also be required to provide services (professional, technical and business) on full and final settlement of NITS's Land Lease Rent with authority (ies) concerned including BIS Management.
11. GST Remittance within the stipulated date and time every month taking into account of Input Tax Credit, Reverse Charge Mechanism, etc. Taking all actions in respect of GST (GSTR 2A reconciliation on monthly basis, etc.) and enlightening of GOI Notifications to NITS from time to time. Filing of monthly and annual GST returns within the stipulated date and time as per GOI'S notifications issued from time to time.
12. Handling of all accounts and finance matters or any related communications on behalf of NITS to the existing and past vendors/parties.
13. The Chartered Accountant shall file litigation in all accounts and finance matters or any relevant matters on behalf of NITS.
14. Any other work(s) relating to accounts/statutory requirements etc., as and when required by the NITS.
15. The Firm accounting professional shall visit the office every fortnight to assess and guide the routine work and to ensure the work are being carried out as per accounting principles and GOI's notification from time to time in respect of all taxes.
16. Onsite Accounts' Personnel:
 - (a) The Firm shall deploy at least one [01] dedicated on-site Accountant (practicing) or Accountant with commerce graduation having ability to understand Govt's Tax Issues, NITS's Accounts' Work, Handling Internal and External Audits, etc., and to provide Service in both online and offline modes. The Firm can deploy more than one onsite accounts personnel, at its own cost. On-site Personnel Service Duration would be as per NITS's needs and requirements which may be at-least 20 to 22 working days in a month.
 - (b) The firm shall be responsible for efficient performance of the contract and for the good conduct of the personnel deputed. NITS' reserves the right to monitor the accounts personnel deputed by the Firm as well as to give working instructions directly to the personnel, if it is necessary in the opinion of the NITS. Onsite-Accounts Personnel must observe all reasonable instructions of the NITS.
 - (c) In the event of onsite-personnel being on leave/absent, the Firm shall ensure suitable alternate arrangement to make up for such absence. To meet such eventualities, the Firm shall make provision for leave reserve.
 - (d) The Firm only, and not the NITS shall be liable for meeting all statutory liabilities of the deployed personnel which shall be inclusive of, but not limited to, the provisions of Employees Provident Fund Act, Employees State Insurance Act, Minimum Wages Act, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act, and any other law in force, or that may come in force in the future.
 - (e) The Firm after setting antecedents verified from police authorities shall issue identity cards/identification documents to its personnel who will be instructed by the Firm to

display the same. NITS shall have the right to inspect the performance of the person (s) deployed by the Firm order for replacing their deployment. The Firm shall make them known about this position in writing before deployment.

17. Unless written consent is given by the NITS, the contract or any part, share or interest in it, must not be transferred or assigned by the Firm, directly or indirectly to any person whomsoever.
18. The accounting works which are originated before the award of contract and also at the time of award of contract in respect of all jobs, as mentioned above from serial no. 1 to 15, shall be taken up by the Firm from the previous CA Firm.
19. If any Firm quote abnormally low bid, it shall not be treated as a valid quote and shall result in summarily dismissal of the financial bid even though the Firm is otherwise technically qualified.
