2. **Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs):** Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Certificate and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. The buyers are advised to refer the [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

3. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Service Provider (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% of margin of purchase preference /price band as defined in the relevant policy, then 100% order quantity will be awarded to such MSE bidder subject to acceptance of L1 bid price.

4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

For lumpsum-based service contracts, the buyer may increase the scope of work and contract value up to 25 percent with the consent of the service provider

The Additional Terms and Conditions (ATC) have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of their Competent Authority. The Buyer is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC clauses shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the Buyer regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers/Service Providers shall ensure full compliance with all applicable labour laws, including the provisions, rules, schemes and guidelines under the four Labour Codes i.e. the Code on Wages, 2019; the Industrial Relations Code, 2020; the Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020; and the Code on Social Security, 2020 as and when notified and brought into force by the Government of India.

For all provisions of the Labour Codes that are pending operationalisation through rules, schemes or notifications, the corresponding provisions of the pre-existing labour enactments (such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, etc. and relevant State Rules) shall continue to remain applicable.


The Medical Superintendent, ESIC Hospital Udyogmandal, invites bids from interested C&AG-empanelled Chartered Accountant firms to assist in the timely preparation and submission of financial statements, including March Provisional and March Final, so as to ensure the finalization of the Corporation's accounts within prescribed timelines and the accuracy of entries recorded by various units.

Employees' State Insurance Corporation is a statutory body under the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Government of India. The Employees' State Insurance Scheme, established under the Employees' State Insurance Act of 1948, is a comprehensive social security insurance program designed to provide social security to Insured Persons / dependents as defined by the Act, against the impact of contingencies of sickness, maternity, disablement and death due to employment injury and to provide medical care to insured persons and their families. The ESI Act is applicable to all non-seasonal factories and establishments as per notification of appropriate Governments. The ESI Act, 1948 applies to factories/establishment employing 10 or more persons. The employees of registered factories and establishments drawing wages up to Rs. 21,000/- per month (Rs. 25,000/- for Persons with Disability) are covered under the Act.

- 1.1. Terms of reference:** Guidelines/Instruction for empanelment of C&AG empanelled Chartered Accountant (CA) firm(s) to assist in timely preparation/submission of financial statement, in order to ensure finalization of Accounts of the Corporation within timelines and correctness of the various entries carried out therein by various accounting units.
- 1.2. Period of Contract:** The period of Contract of the Appointment of the selected bidder shall be for a period of one year i.e. **FY 2026-27** (which may be extended till finalization of Accounts by ESIC Headquarters). The rates quoted shall remain same during the entire period of the contract. ESIC, however, reserves the right to terminate the contract by serving one month notice in writing and the contractor in turn has to give three months' notice.
- 1.3. Location of Work:** Empanelled CA Firm must have **an office in Kerala**, preferably in Ernakulam district.

- 2.1 The applicant firm must have a **minimum of five (5) consecutive years** of experience as on 31.03.26 in executing similar works/services for Government Departments, Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs), or Autonomous Bodies. **(Annexure B)**
- 2.2 Only the bids submitted by firms that have **duly completed and signed all annexure** (Annexures A to G) attached at the end of this document will be considered.
- 2.3 Applicant firm should have a **registered office in Kerala**.
- 2.4 Applicant firm should be **empanelled with C&AG** and ESIC holds the rights to terminate the contract if CA firm or any of its partners/members get debarred and/or blacklisted by any Centre/State Government organisation, statutory Organisation or PSU.
- 2.5 The applicant firm must have a minimum average annual financial turnover of **₹50 Lakhs** during the last three (3) consecutive financial years. Furthermore, the firm must not have incurred any financial loss during this three-year period.
- 2.6 Applicant firm and its partner should not have been held guilty of any professional misconduct under Chartered Accountants Act, 1949 (as amended) during last five years or penalized under any of the tax laws by ICAI (Institute of Chartered Accountants of India) or any government/statutory Organisation or PSU.
- 2.7 Applicant firm or its partners should not be facing any investigation or enquiry by any tax authority for violation of any of the tax laws and did not face any such litigation before Hon'ble Court(s).

4.2 Scrutiny of Accounts for financial year 2026-27 keeping in view classification of income and expenditure including verification of accounting adjustments/rectification of errors, omission in books of accounts and clearing suspense entries. All effort should be made to ensure that:

- a) The expenditures are 100% reconciled with the statements (R&P) of concerned unit.
- b) There are no obvious errors in accounts like "Minus balances in receipt and expenditure. Such balances need to be examined in detail and rectification entry need to be passed before sending accounts to headquarters.
- c) The accounts are free of all mathematical errors/mistakes.
- d) Expenditures under all account's heads are tallied with respective subsidiary ledgers.
- e) Any unusual increase/decrease/divergent trend in any head of expense is examined and rectified.
- f) Ensure that all financial transactions are accurately classified under their respective expenditure heads—specifically distinguishing between Hospital Services, Medical Education, Regional Offices, and Sub-Regional Offices. Additionally, proper accounting disclosure and classification must be maintained for all prior period items.
- g) Verification of physical verification of cash in hand and reconciliation with cash book should be done.
- h) Verification of reconciliation of Bank Balance with Bank statement should be done.
- i) Verification of reconciliation of all statutory dues (not limited to TDS, TDS on GST) should be done properly.
- j) Verification and reconciliation of security deposit, unclassified receipt, Pension payments, NPS, miscellaneous advances on monthly basis should be done properly.
- k) Verification and reconciliation of exchange account and suspense slip should be done properly.
- l) Verifying of accounting of all disposed assets along with profit/loss should be done properly.



4.6 The engaged CA firm must ensure its officials are well versed in the provision of 7th CPC pay commission and provide necessary assistance in IT calculation.




- 4.12 Further, any other financial opinion/help/guidance/verification/vetting required/sought by Financial Commissioner and Director General, ESIC Headquarters in any matter. Any other financial report and compilation required by financial division.
- 4.13 The above scope of work is indicative in nature and may be enhanced/curtailed as per the requirements of the division.
- 4.14 Ensure that all statutory and local laws are being abided by ESIC hospital, Udyogmandal with respect to financial transactions

5. Report

The detailed report(s) of visiting will be submitted in single hard copy to the Administrative Head and the Finance head of the ESIC hospital, Udyogmandal. Further, the Administrative Head and the Finance head of this hospital will forward the said report with analysis/findings and recommendations (if any) to Financial Commissioner/Additional Commissioner, ESIC Headquarters. 6. Payment


Monthly remuneration may be paid to the empanelled agency in accordance with the visits paid by the CA as per the bill raised by the empanelled agency and visits acknowledge by units in respect of work assigned and performed as defined in scope of work subject to the satisfaction of work and report submitted by empanelled CA firm. All mandatory deductions like Taxes/TDS as applicable shall be done as per statutory provisions. 8. Termination of Contract:

If service provider is found responsible for any leakage of information, lobbying, bribing etc., then ESIC have the right to terminate the contract and if required as per applicable law, action deemed fit may be initiated against the empanelled CA firm. Also, if cumulative penalties reach **10%** of contract value, competent authority may terminate the contract.


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





9. Standard Terms & Conditions for the service for agreement:

- 9.1 The persons deployed shall, during the course of their work, shall have access to the classified documents, which they are not supposed to divulge to any third party(s), and shall maintain confidentiality. Any breach of this confidentiality obligation shall make the service provider liable for penal action under the applicable laws besides action for breach of contract.

- 9.6 The successful contractor shall sign an agreement with ESIC with standard terms and conditions for providing professional services of Chartered Accountant/firm.
- 9.7 The Contractor (CA) or his representative will have to appear before competent authority as and when required due to exigency of Monthly/Annual Accounts related works.
- 9.8 The engaged firm will be responsible for any corrections arising out of their own faults at no further cost to this office.
- 9.9 The Responsibility of correctness and accuracy of the details collected from the records of ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal will lie with the CA firm engaged.
- 9.10 A reasonable penalty may be imposed on the CA firm engaged by ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal as decided, if it is found that the firm failed to perform its obligations in any manner. Such penalty may be deducted from the payment to be made to the CA firm after giving a written notice.
- 9.11 The engaged CA Firm shall maintain high standards of integrity and professional ethics and morality while handling the work of ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal and its officials. If it is found that this condition of confidentiality is compromised by the firm, then ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal will be at liberty to take further steps (e.g., requesting ICAI for cancellation of license) against the CA Firm.

- 9.12 Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal Office reserves the right to discontinue the services of the CA Firm in the event their services are evaluated as unsatisfactory at any time during the period.
- 9.13 Any losses sustained by ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal due to negligence in the services of the Chartered Accountant firm, including loss or damage to property attributable to its employees or manpower, shall be recoverable from the firm. The monetary value of such losses shall be assessed by ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal, and the decision of the Medical Superintendent in this regard shall be final and binding on the firm..
- 9.14 The engaged CA firm shall provide full details of their representative with qualification etc. Such representative will carry identity card of the firm during visit to this office and shall maintain the decorum of the office.
- 9.15 The Contractor / Firm **shall not be allowed** to transfer, assign, pledge or subcontract its rights and liabilities under this contract to any other agency.
- 9.16 Service charge/consultancy charge or any other charges will not be paid separately for any of the services mentioned in scope of work.
- 9.17 The CA firm shall bear all expenses regarding compensations, wages and allowances (Daily allowance & Travelling allowance), PF, ESI, Bonus and Gratuity as applicable relating to personnel engaged by him and abide by the provisions of various labour legislations. Payment to the firm shall be made on basis on submission of bill by the firm and on rendering satisfactory service by the firm.

- 9.21 In the event of person deputed by CA firm being on leave/absent, the CA firm shall ensure suitable alternative arrangement to make up for such absence.
- 9.22 If any of the personnel of the engaged CA firm indulges in theft or any illegal/irregular activities, misconduct, the CA firm shall take appropriate action as per law and rules against



its erring personnel in consultation with this office and intimate the action taken to this office. If need be, an FIR may be lodged against the erring personnel. Such personnel, who indulge in such type of activities, should not be further employed in this office by the firm in any case.

9.23 This Contract may be terminated at any time if the work is not satisfactory. The CA firm shall abide by all statutory laws applicable to it.

9.24 Breach of Contract: In case of breach of any terms and conditions attached to the contract, the Performance Security Deposit of the Contractor will be liable to be forfeited by ESIC besides annulment of the contract.

9.25 Liquidated damages: For any lapse on the part of firm in relation to the work, penalty as decided by the competent authority may be imposed which shall be binding on the firm. The decision of ESIC official in-charge shall be final in this regard.

9.26 The Contractor / Firm shall comply by all laws, rules and regulations framed there under or any other statutory obligations which are in force from time to time. The Contractor / Firm shall indemnify ESIC Hospital, Udyogmandal from any claims in this regard.

9.27 Force Majeure: ESIC may consider relaxing the requirements, as specified in this document, if and to the extent that, the performance or other failure to perform its obligations under the contract is the result of Force Majeure. Force Majeure is defined as an event of effect that cannot reasonably be anticipated such as acts of God (like earthquakes, floods, storms etc.), acts of states / state agencies, the direct and indirect consequences of wars (declared or undeclared), hostilities, national emergencies, civil commotion and strikes at successful Bidder's premises or any other act beyond control of the bidder.
